Conversation between the DWP and the BPS

- The DWP asked the BPS to comment on their proposals for welfare reform, & on the ongoing progress of welfare reform
- Autumns of 2010 and 2011: the BPS provided the DWP with two reports. In these reports, the BPS expressed their concerns about Government thinking & planned changes to benefits
- June 2015: the BPS wrote a briefing paper, “calling on the new Government to commission an end-to-end redesign of the Work Capability Assessment (WCA) process – including its outcomes & periods for reassessment”

BPS – WE NOW CALL ON YOU TO DO MORE

- 2011-2014 **2,380 people died** shortly after being declared able to work
- Government & corporate collaborators are imposing psychological explanations for unemployment, together with mandatory activities intended to modify beliefs, attitude, disposition, or personality—**Psychocompulsion** (Friedli & Stearn, 2015)
- **The United Nations** “is deeply concerned about the various changes in the entitlements to, & cuts in, social benefits introduced by the Welfare Reform Act 2012 & the Welfare Reform & Work Act 2016”. The UN has called on the Government to: “Review the entitlement conditions & **reverse the cuts** in social security benefits introduced by” these Acts.
